



# Trewirgie Infants' & Nursery School

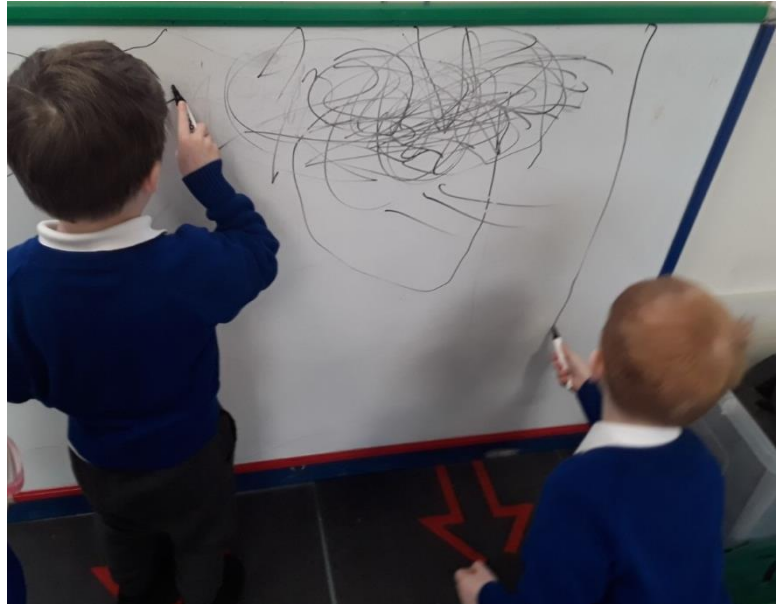
