The whole school looked at the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and re-worded it in “child-speak”. A sample is below:

Trewirgie Infants’ Summary of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child

“I have the right to stay safe.” Article 19

“I have the right to make friends with anybody I choose, no matter what their, or my own, beliefs might be.” Articles 14 + 15

“I have the right to go to school, be respected and learn new things. I have the right to develop my talents and personality at school; to respect and be respected by others.”
Articles 28 + 29

“If someone hasn’t got anyone to play with, you can say, ‘Do you want to play with me?’” *Year 1 boy*

“Learning about the Right to clean water has made me realise I must not waste water.” *Year 2 girl*



All classes are involved in writing their own Class Charters every September.
