## Throughout Key Stage 1:

- Children continue the Read, Write, Inc programme which focuses on the learning of synthetic phonics to promote blending, segmenting and decoding words.
- During the RWI lessons children are heard reading one of the RWI reading books which is carefully chosen to correspond to the level of the RWI group.
- Children who complete the RWI scheme will work on comprehension and writing skills during these sessions.
- Children are encouraged to read alien and high frequency words at intervals during the day.
- Pupils continue to follow the school's reading scheme "Storyworlds". Each evening a reading book will be sent home and children will be heard reading their books in the class at least once a week.
- The reading scheme is supplemented by books from the "Project X" scheme and children are encouraged to "platform" their reading, thus achieving a sense of purpose and enjoyment.
- There will be termly opportunities for children to learn a new story, building upon their storytelling into writing skills.
- Storytelling plays a vital part in the children's education at this stage and there will be opportunities for children to hear a selection of poems and stories on a daily basis.
