






Dear Parents,

Over the last few weeks police officers have attended the area and passed on words of advice to numerous drivers about the parking situation at school drop off and collection times. Despite these efforts vehicles are still parking illegally and in potentially dangerous locations.

Whilst some drivers have appreciated the advice given and have moved on, we would like to highlight that it is not as we have 'nothing better to do' but because safeguarding children is a high priority and as parents we would like to think you all agree with this.

In the coming weeks officers will patrol the area and if vehicles still continue to break the law then stronger action may be taken. This may mean you need to park further away or arrive earlier so bear this in mind when you set off. Also if you drive a works vehicle please ensure your insurance covers the school run and finally please place children in the correct seat and location in vehicles.




This is NOT acceptable.

Please note the parking regulations in the area below.



You should not be stopping on double yellow lines or the 'Zig Zag' markings even for just a short while. These areas are key to keeping the road safe.



You should also not be stopping on single yellow lines between the times shown on the relevant sign nearby.
